Chart 1 Alumni Of Al-Ameen, Contribute To Development Of College And Handling Grievances

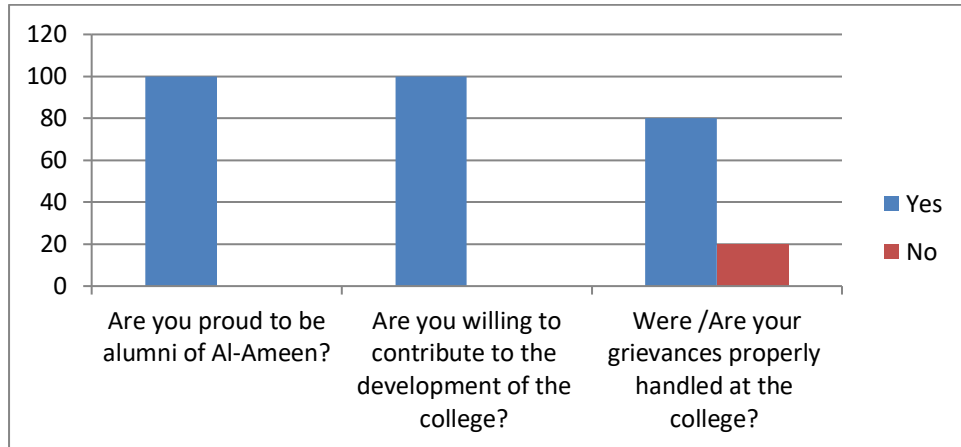

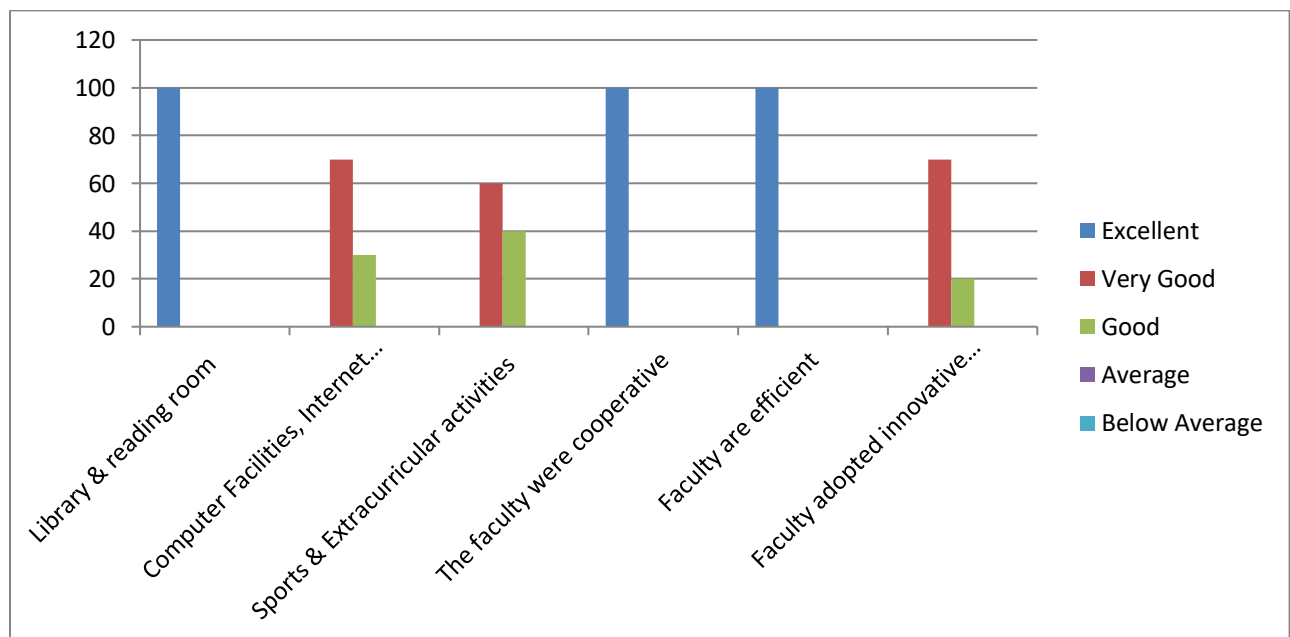
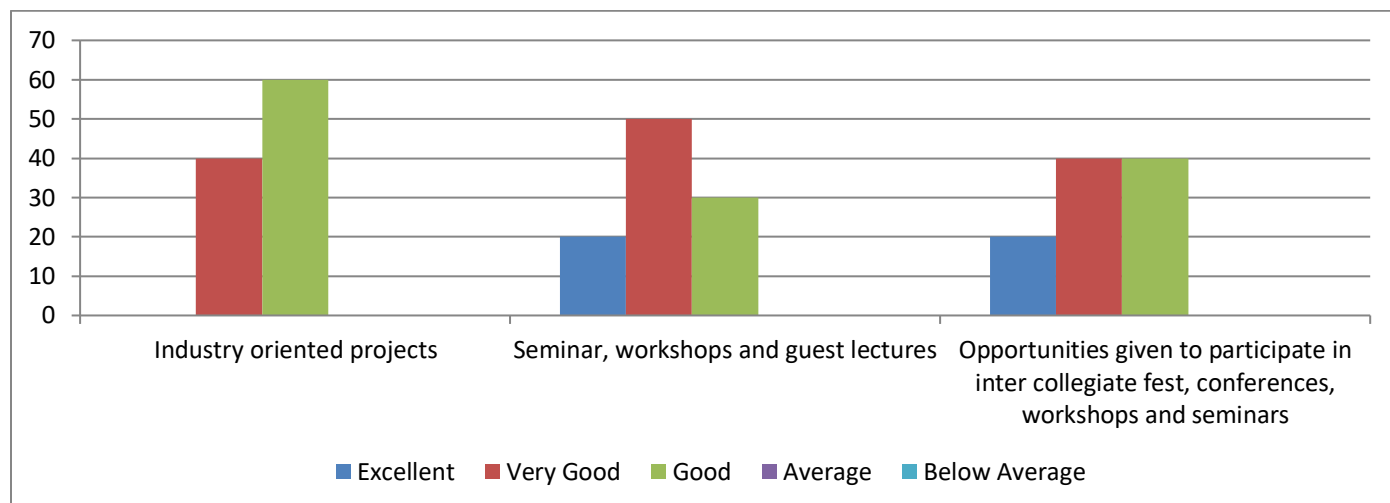

Chat 4 Reporting Inculcate Entrepreneurial Skills And Campus Placement Opportunities

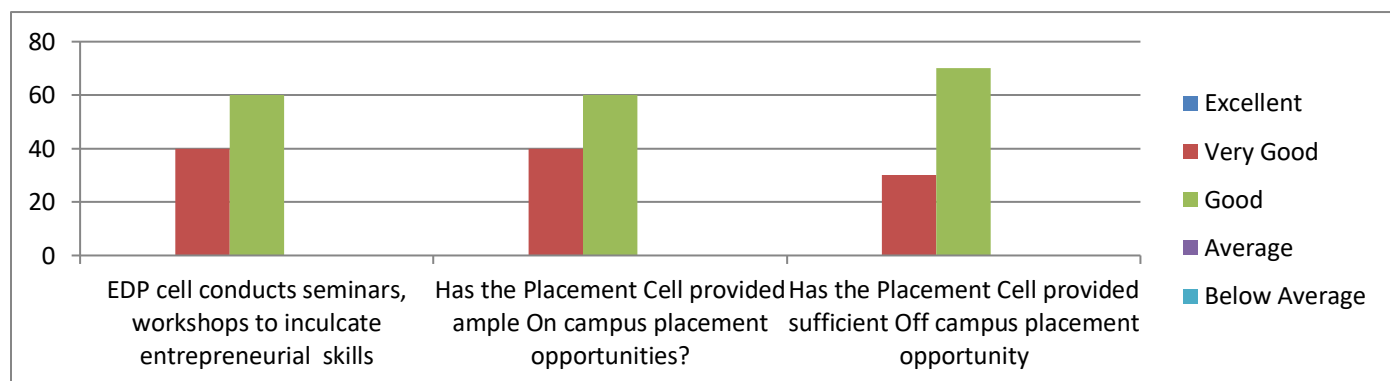


Chart 5 Reporting Career Counseling And Guidance, Guest Lectures, Joining Alumni Association, Alumni Meet And Regular Updates

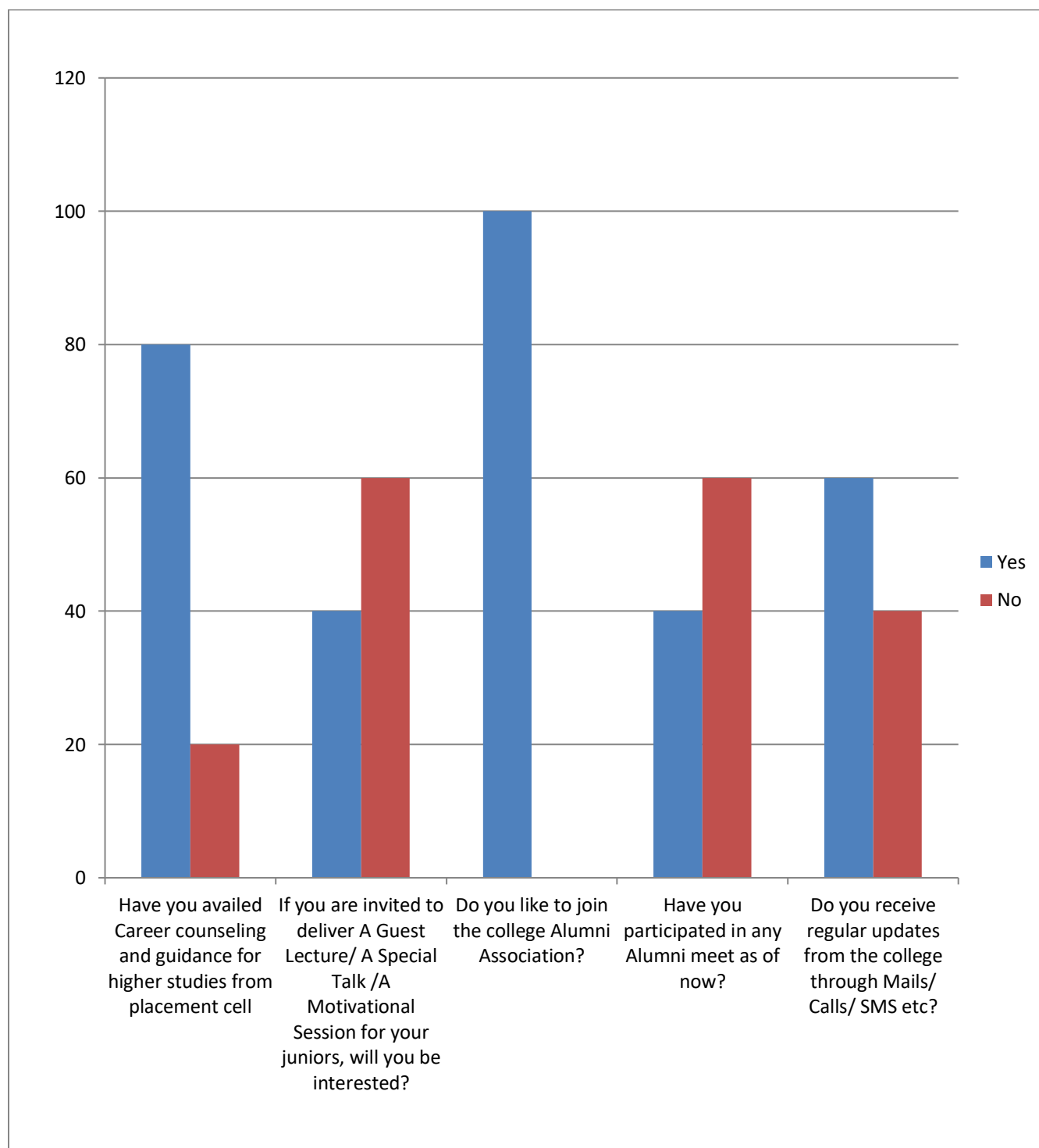
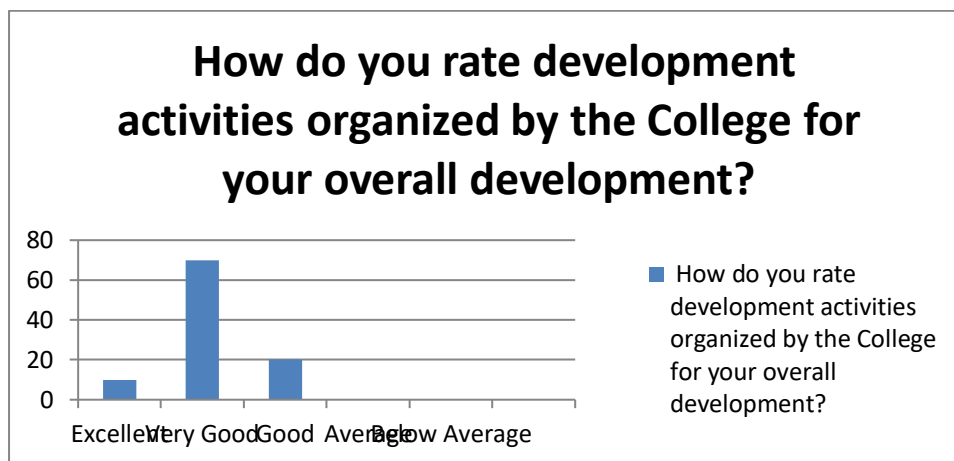


Chart 6 How Do You Rate Development Activities Organized By The College For Your Overall Development?

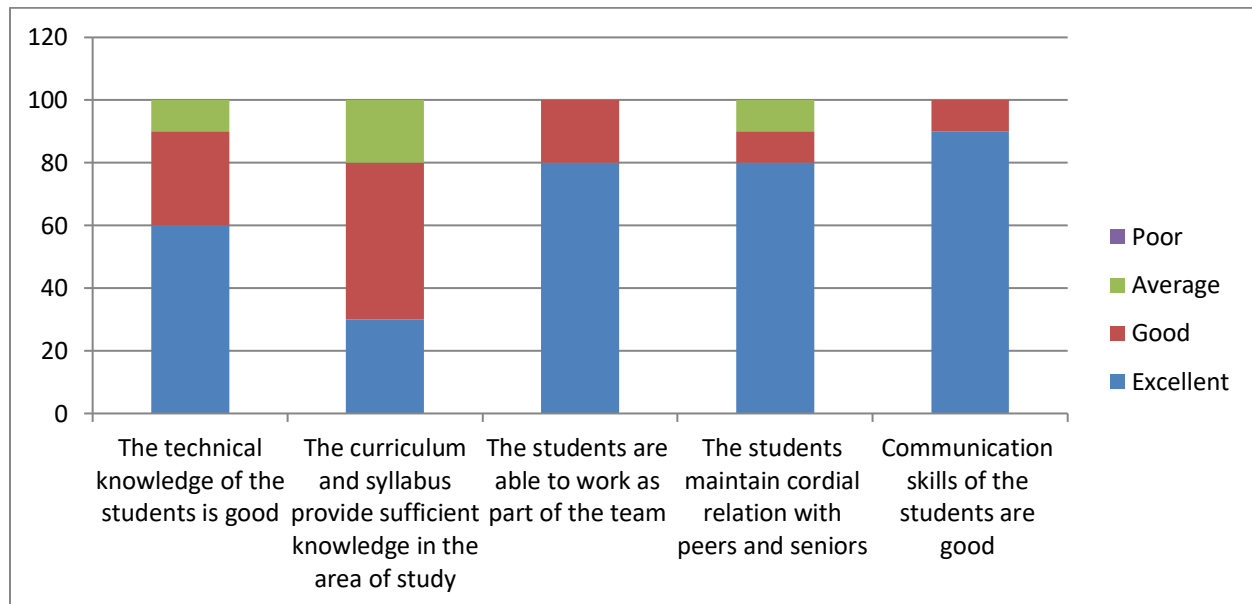
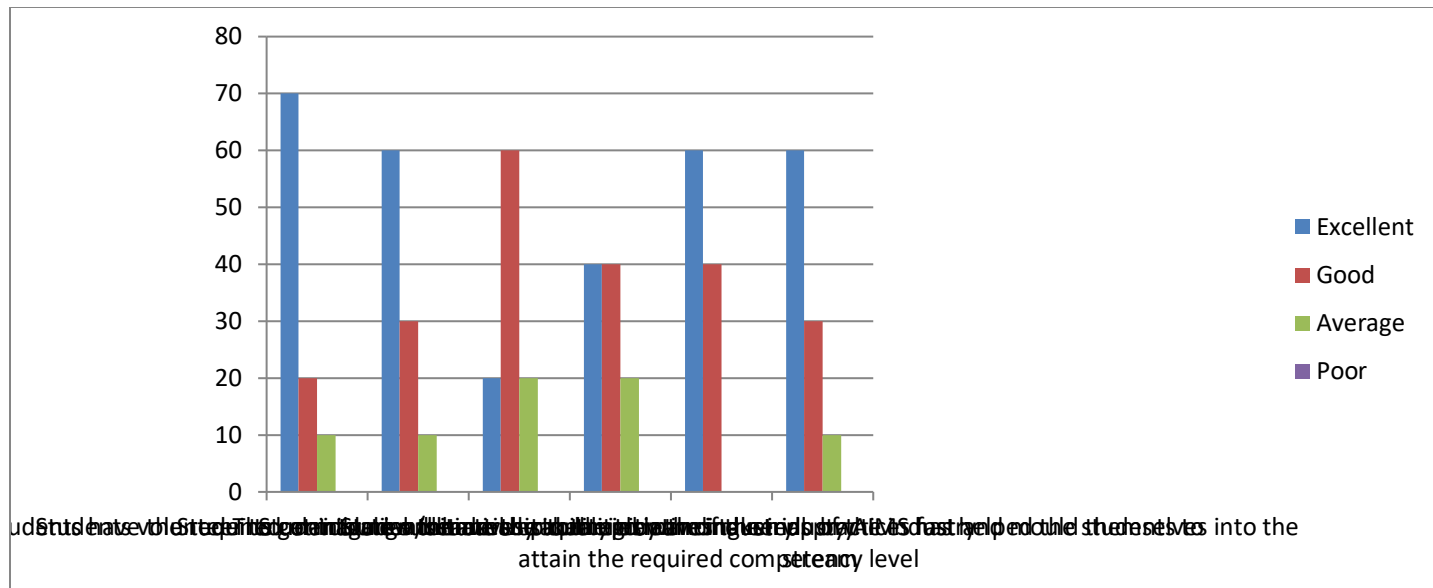

Chart 1 reporting curriculum and syllabi, syllabi, course deliver, usage of teaching aids and ICT, fairness in assessment

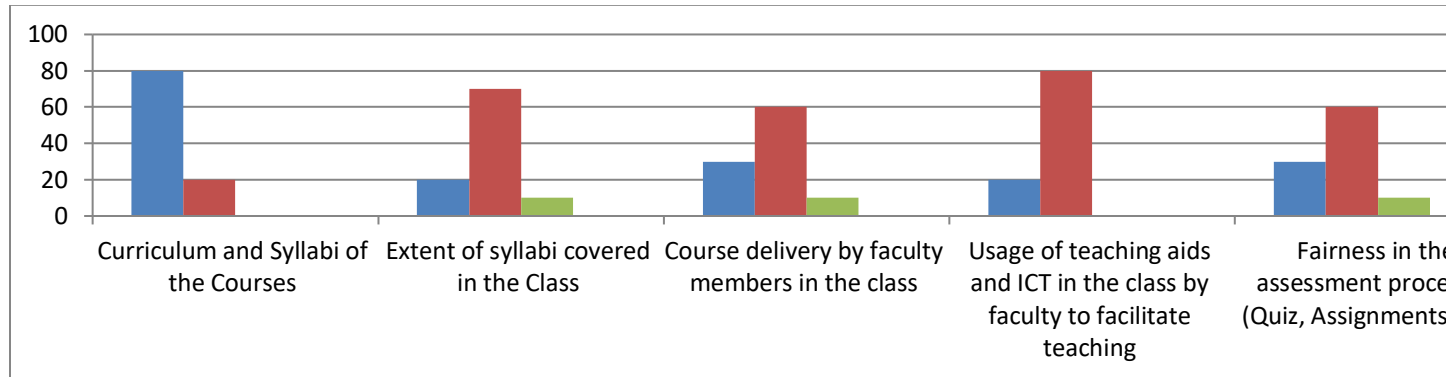


Chart 2 reporting timely announcement of examination, opportunities for research activities , internship , student exchange and field visit

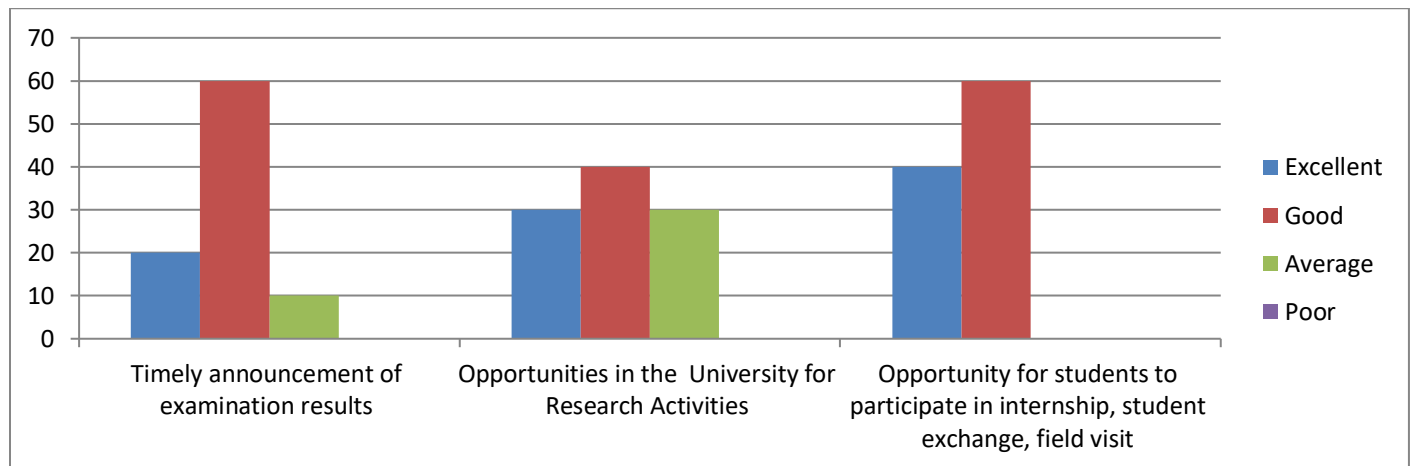
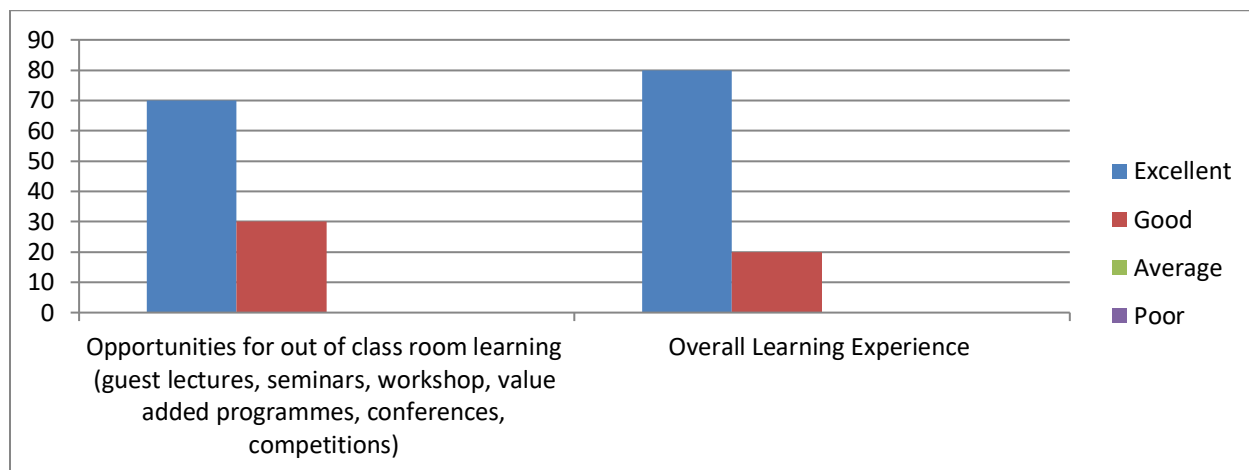


Chart 3 reporting opportunities for out of class room learning and overall learning experience

Chart 1 Reporting Curriculum and Syllabus are need based

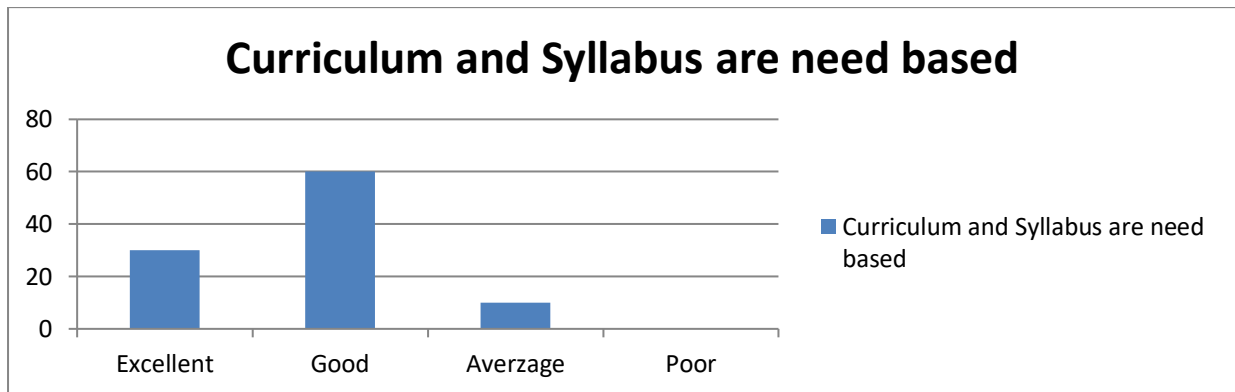


Chart 2 Reporting The Course Outcomes Are Well Defined And Clear

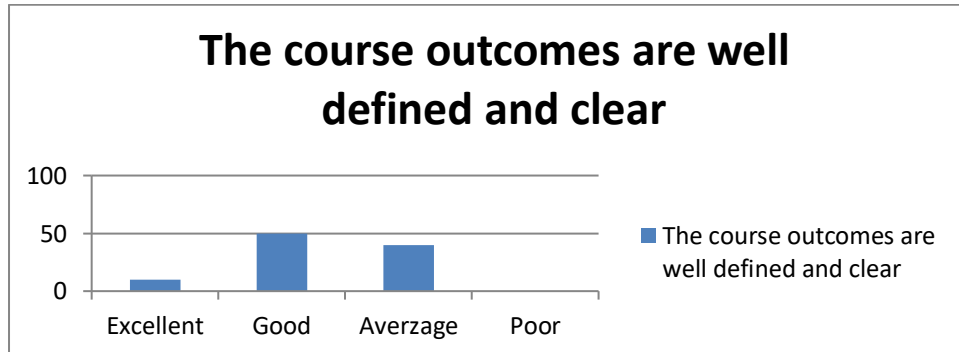


Chart 3 Reporting Sufficient Number Of Relevant Reading Materials And Digital Resources Are Available In The Library

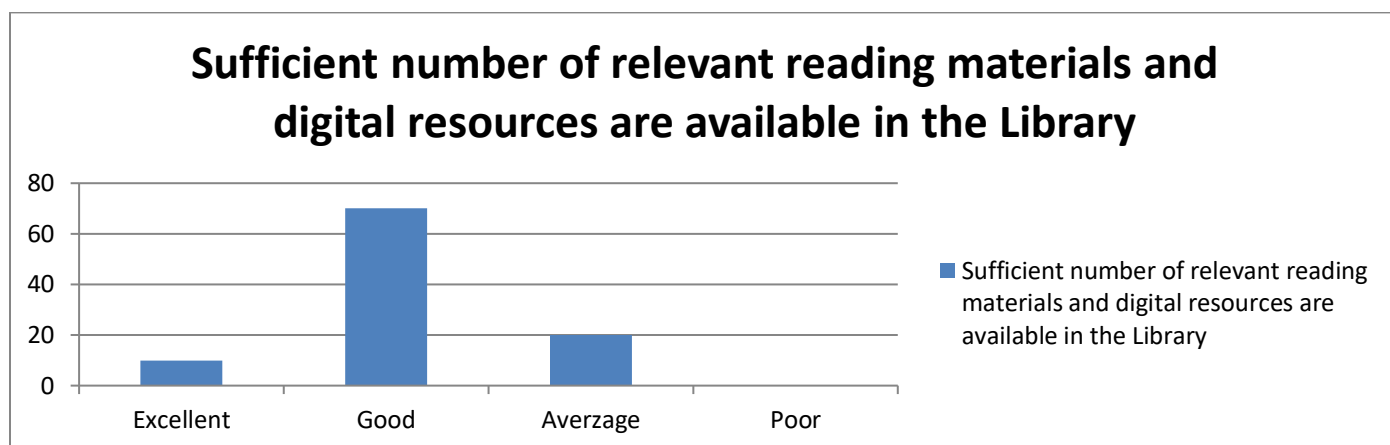


Chart 4 Reporting The Course Has Good Balance Between Theory And Application

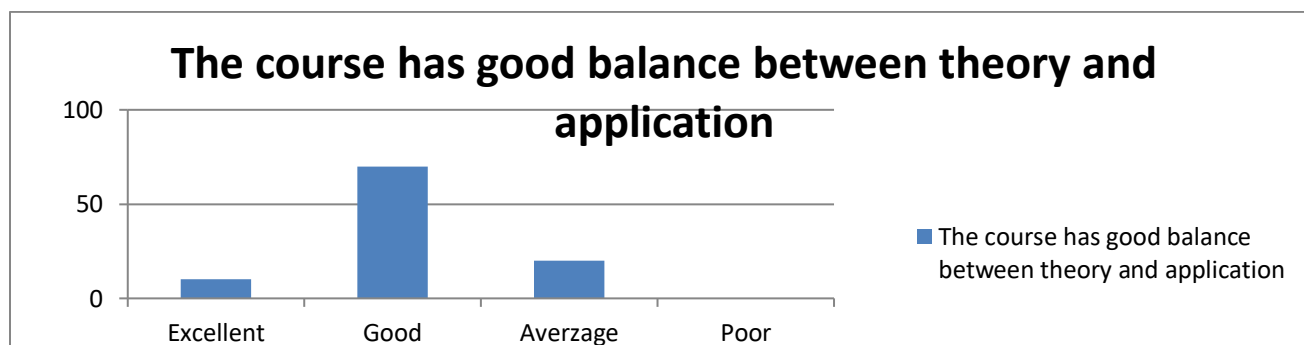


Chart 5 Reporting I Have The Freedom To Propose, Modify, Suggest And Incorporate New Topic In The Syllabus Through Proper Forum

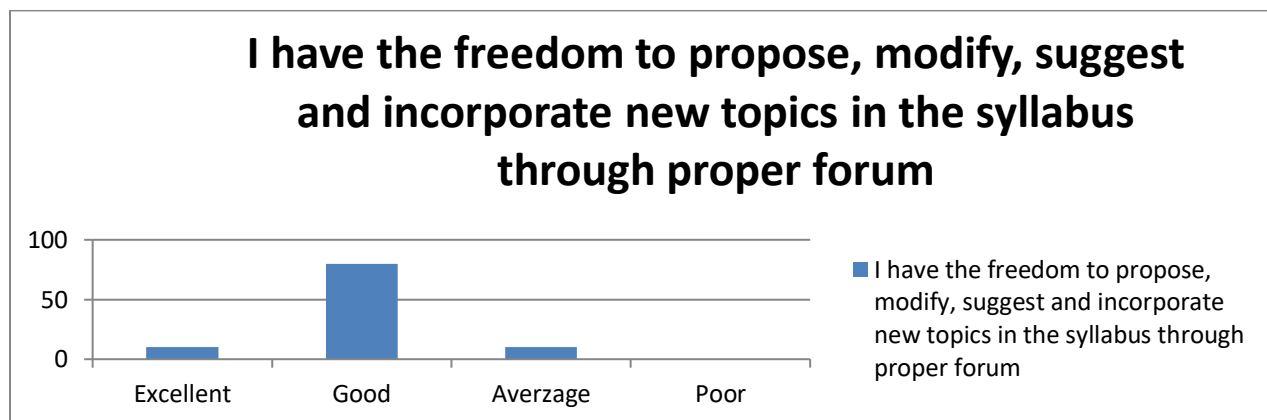


Chart 6 Reporting I Have The Freedom To Adopt New Techniques/Education Tools/Strategies In Teaching

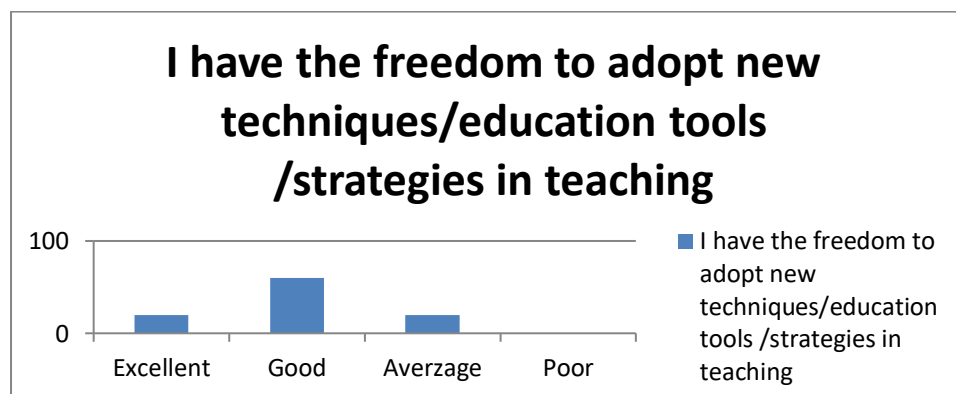


Chart 7 Reporting I Am Able To Achieve The Minimum Required Course Outcome Attainment Level For My Class

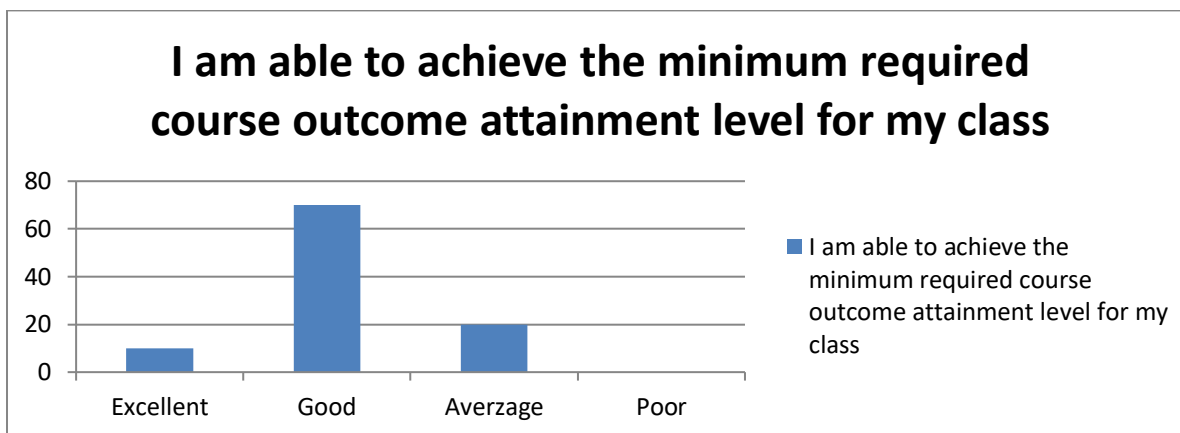


Chart 8 Reporting I Have Taken Sufficient Steps To Provide Assistance To Slow Learners

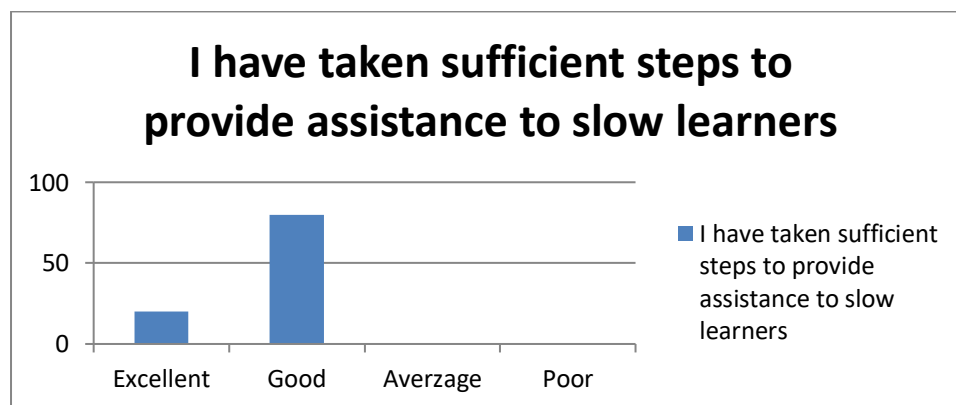
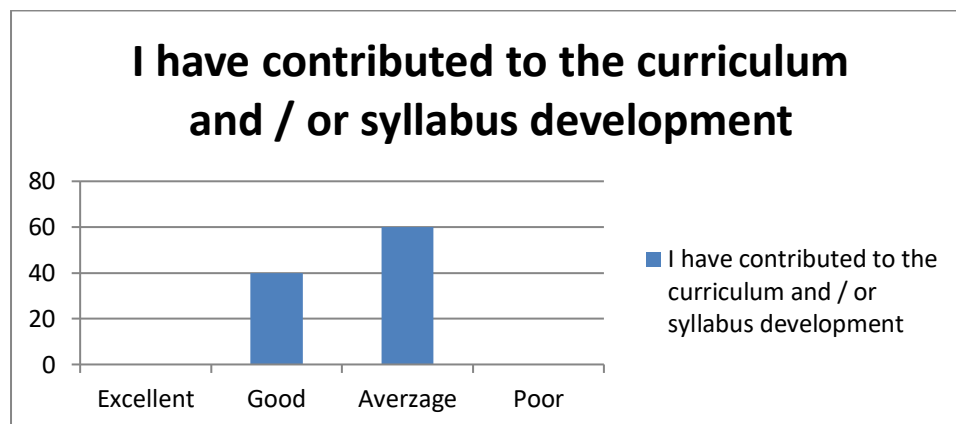


Chart 9 Reporting I Have Contributed To The Curriculum And/or Syllabus Development
