Chart 1 Representing Feed Back On The Course

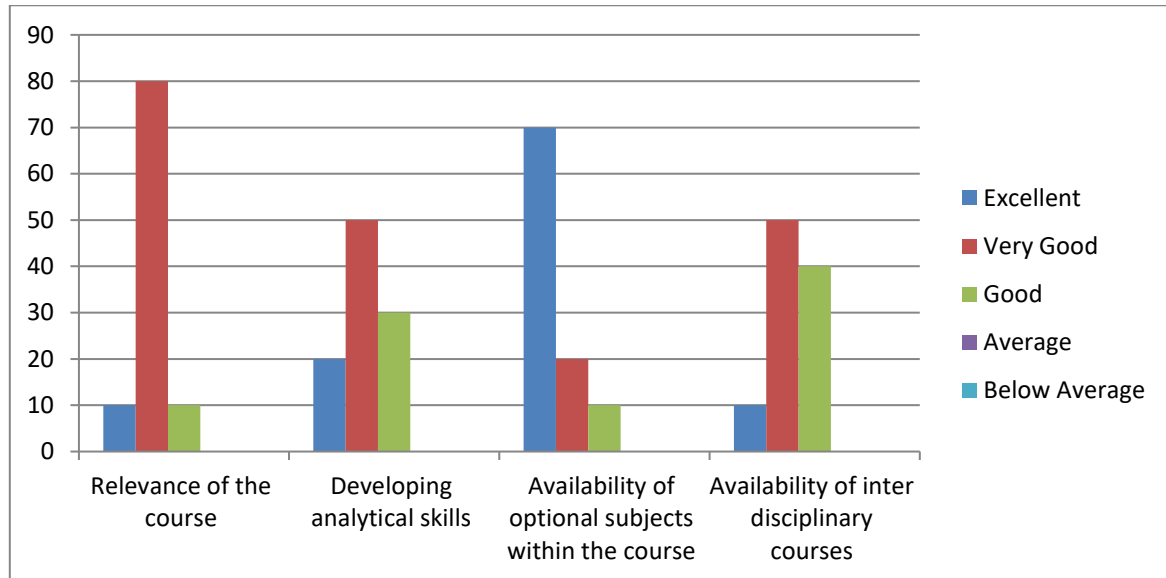


Chart 2 Representing Feed Back About The Teachers

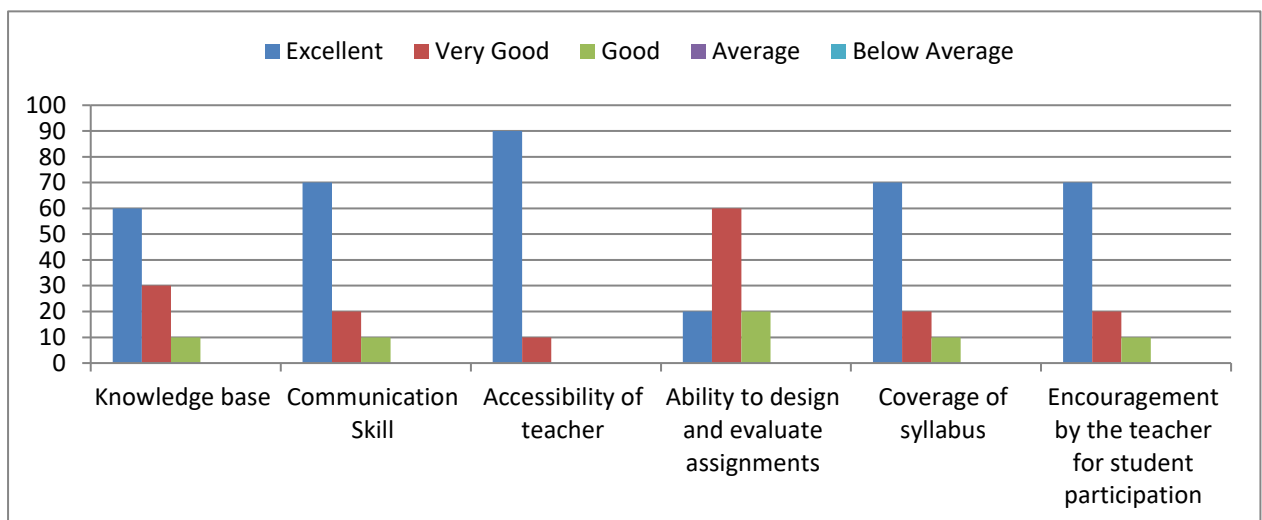


Chart 3 Representing Feed Back About Library

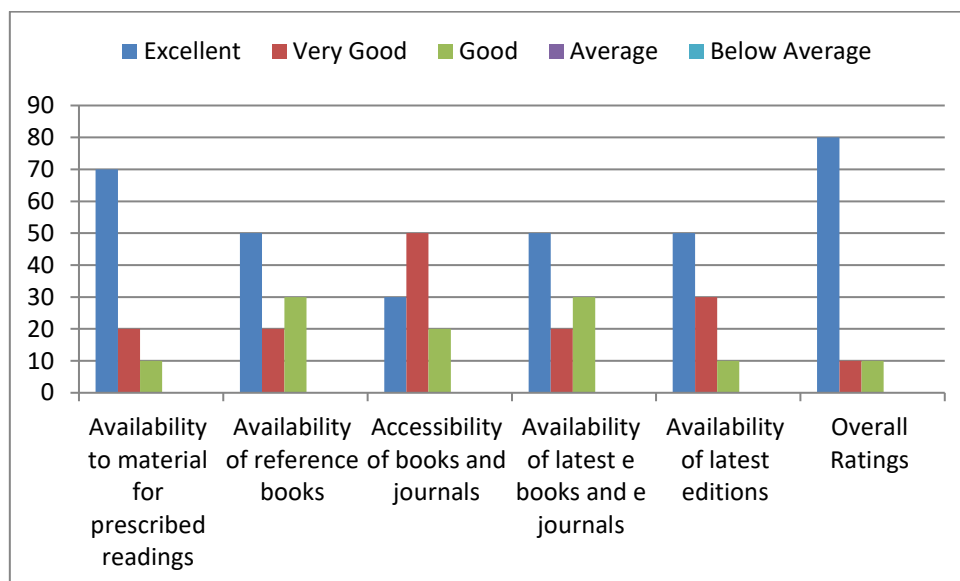


Chart 4 Representing Feed Back About Internal Assessment

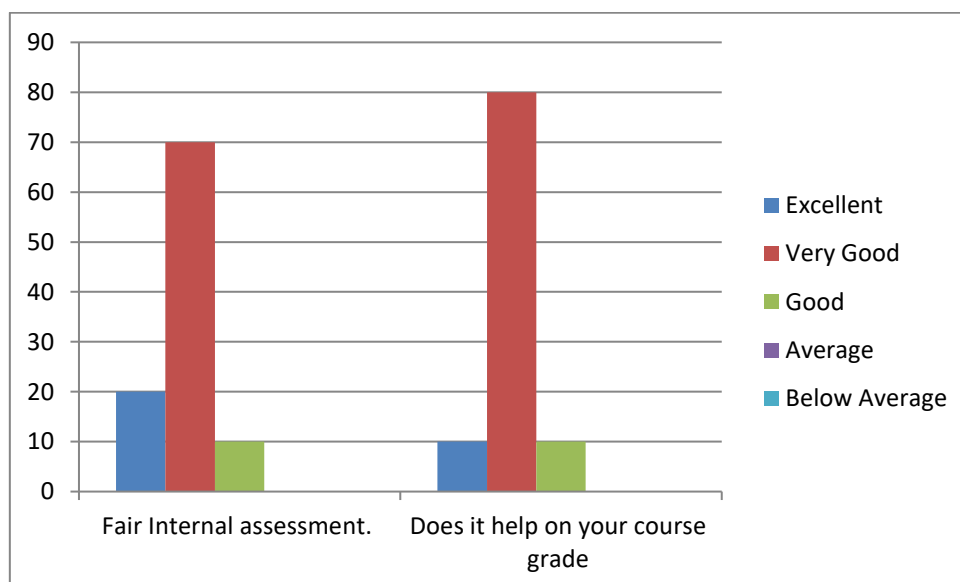


Chart 5 Representing Feed Back About Infrastructure

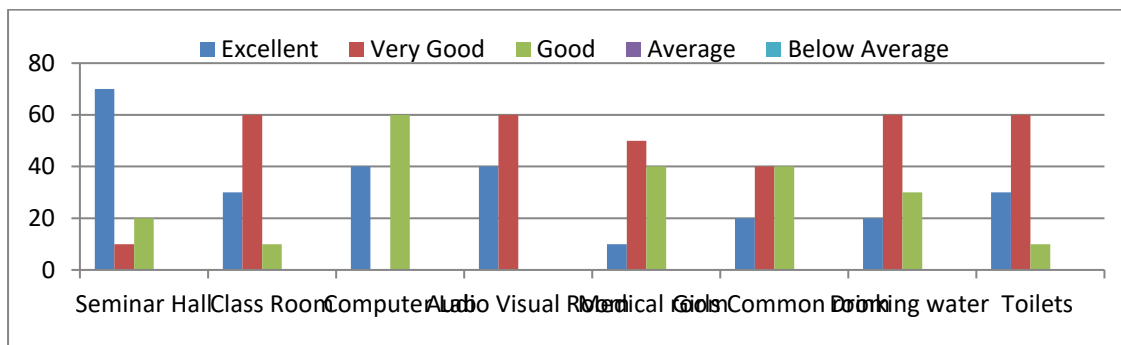
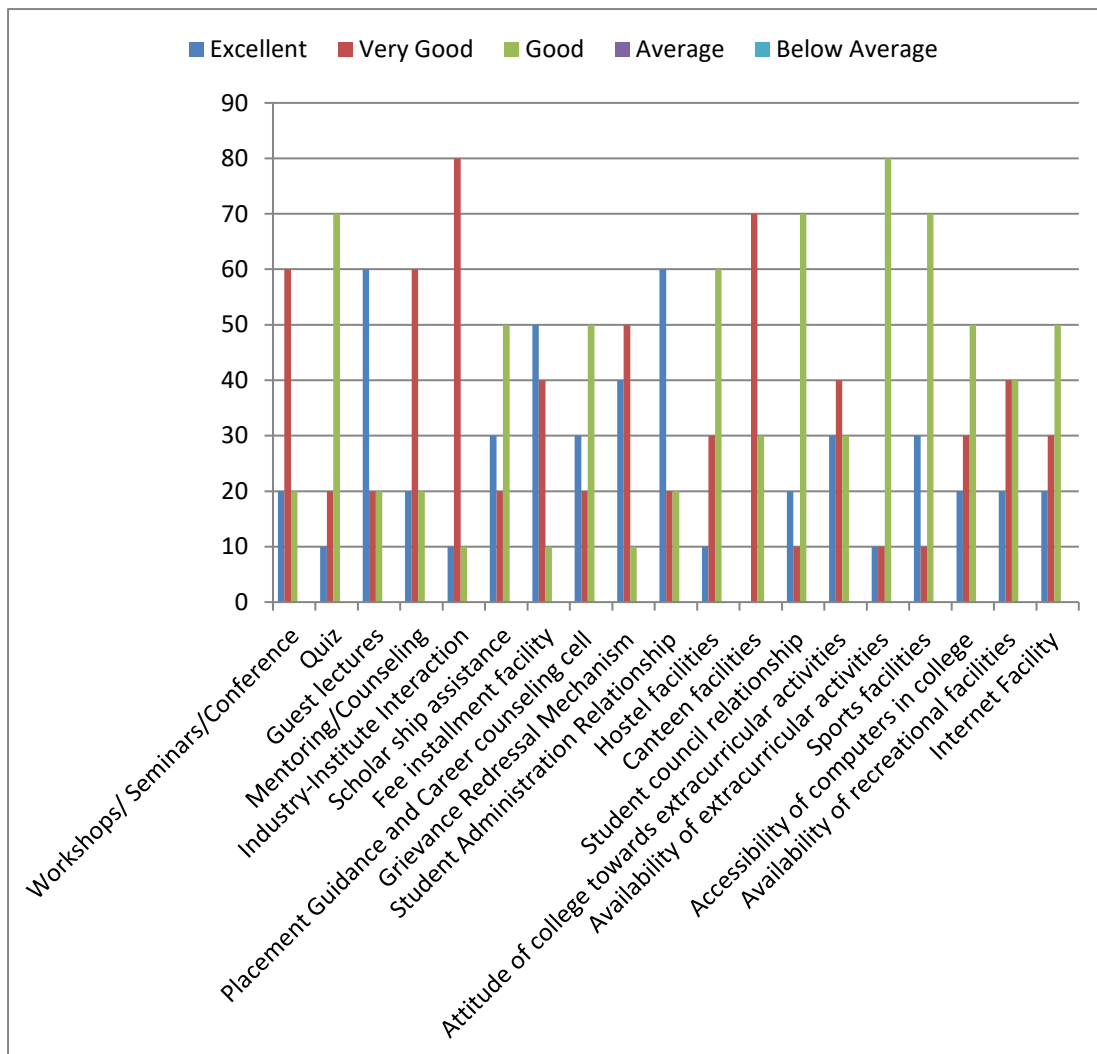


Chart 6 Representing Institutional Environment



Findings

Feed Back On the Course

- 70% of the students have rated Excellent for availability of optional subjects within the course.
- Majority of the students have rated Very Good for developing analytical skills, availability of inter disciplinary courses and the relevance of the course

Feed Back About the Teachers

- Majority of the students have rated Excellent regarding the knowledge, communication, accessibility, coverage of the syllabus, coverage of syllabus by the teachers and encouragement by the teachers for students participation.
- 60% of the students have rated Very Good for the ability to design and evaluate the assignments.

Feedback about Library

- Majority of the students have rated Excellent for availability to material for prescribed reading, availability of reference books and journals, availability of latest e books and e journals, availability of latest editions and overall.
- 50% of the students have rated Very Good for accessibility of books and journals

Feedback about Internal Assessment

- Majority of the students have rated Very Good for fair internal assessment and does it help on your course grade.

Feedback About Infrastructure

- Majority of the students have rated Excellent for seminar hall.
- Majority of the students have rated Very Good for class room, audio visual room, medical room, girls common room, drinking water and toilets as very good
- 60% of the student have rated Good for computer lab.

Feedback About Institutional Environment

- Most of the students have rated Excellent for guest lectures, fee installment student administration relationship.
- Majority of the students have rated Very Good for workshops/seminars/conference, guest lectures, industry-institute interaction, mentoring/counseling and canteen facilities.

- Most of the student have rated Good for quiz, grievance redressal mechanism, hostel facilities, sports facilities, attitude of the college towards extracurricular activities, accessibility of computer in college, availability of recreational facilities, placement Guidance and career counseling cell, student council relationship, and internet facility.
